Social Media Use Policy

The Club committee would like to remind all users of any social media sites associated with, or operating under the banner of the Club to be mindful of The FA rules and regulations as well as the Club's policies and ethos when making such posts. This includes, but is not limited to, websites and apps such as Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Youtube and Whatsapp.

The Club has committed to uphold The FA's Respect codes of conduct, and policies on safeguarding and social media use, and expects all club officials, parents, supporters and players to follow the same best practice. In line with Huddersfield & District Junior Football League rules, this includes not publishing results of any league games up to and including Under 11, nor any references to personal opinion on this matter.

Self-policing of social media channels is required of all Club members. Any posts deemed to be inappropriate should be brought to the attention of the coach or administrator responsible for the age group concerned, who will then review and, if necessary, remove or request the removal of any such posts.

Any posts deemed to contravene FA, league or Club rules and guidelines may result in sanctions and/or disciplinary action against the person(s) involved, as outlined in the Club Policies, Expected Behaviours and Sanctions document.
